Great location at 2270 Hotel Circle North San Diego, CA 92108 <u>www.cp-sandiego.com</u> Amenities include Wireless Internet, on site restaurant & lounge, heated outdoor pool, room safe. This is a no smoking hotel. We have also secured discounted parking rate of \$4.00 for local and overnight guests per day.

Deadline for reservations August 24, 2017. Our group rate is offered 3 days before and after the reunion based on hotel availability. (Block room are filling up fast don't wait).

King and Queen Room rates are \$122.00 plus tax. Included is a hot breakfast buffet for up to 2 guests per room. If there are three (3) guests in a room, the rate would be \$130.00 and would include breakfast for all three guests. Four (4) guests in a room, the rate would be \$138.00 and include breakfast for all 4 guests.

Airport Transportation to Hotel: The options are Super Shuttle at the rate of \$12 per person, each way or a Taxi which is between \$20-25 each way. Once at the hotel, The Crowne Plaza offers complimentary shuttle to Old Town and the Fashion Valley Mall at scheduled times.

Get Ready For Another Great Time!

Due to many requests for an optional tour on Friday we have put together the bus tour below. **Friday, September 15th:** Narrated City Bus Tour. This tour includes Mount Soledad Veteran's Memorial located in LaJolla 900 feet above sea level with a sweeping 360 degree view of San Diego and the ocean. We will travel through Coronado and by the famous Del Coronado hotel built in 1888. Shopping at Seaport Village and lunch will be at the classic Bali Hai restaurant located on Shelter Island, established in 1954. We will return to the hotel by 3:00pm.

We had mentioned in the February newsletter, dinner at the hotel on Friday night. However, due to high cost of the dinner, **Friday night will be on your own for dinner**.

Saturday, September 16th: USS Midway Tour is the most visited ship in the world. Everyone will receive a complimentary audio set, this allows you to visit your favorite exhibits.
