Amenities include Wireless Internet, on site restaurant & lounge, heated indoor pool, safe, coffee maker, handicap accessible rooms. This is a no smoking hotel. Complimentary self-parking. Valet Parking is \$15.00 plus tax per night.

Blocked rooms are under the name USS Floyd B Parks DD884 Military Reunion. Please wait until February 5, 2018 to call to make your reservation. They are currently setting up the block of rooms. Reservations can be made by calling 215 365-4150 ext.33 Mon-Fri 8am-5pm. Hilton Worldwide 1-800-445-8667 after 5pm or weekends.

The cutoff date for reservations is Monday August 20, 2018. Please do not wait. September is a very popular month for conventions in this city and the hotel fills up fast.

Reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or guaranteed with a major credit card. The cancellation policy is 72 hours prior to arrival. The group rate will be offered 3 days pre and post of the reunion based on hotel availability.

Double and Queen Room rates are \$139.00 plus tax. Discounted Breakfast coupons @ \$14.00 per person inclusive of tax and service charges will be provided at check in. If you decide not to use the breakfast coupons, there will be no charge to you. There is a \$10 charge for each additional adult over 2 adults per room.
